

1.2 Installation - SeaView v3.5.2 for Windows



Uninstalling Prior Versions of SeaView

If you have the "SeaView v3.5 Beta" version installed, or your existing version of SeaView is corrupt, first manually "uninstall" the existing version of SeaView, and then begin the installation process.

To uninstall SeaView:

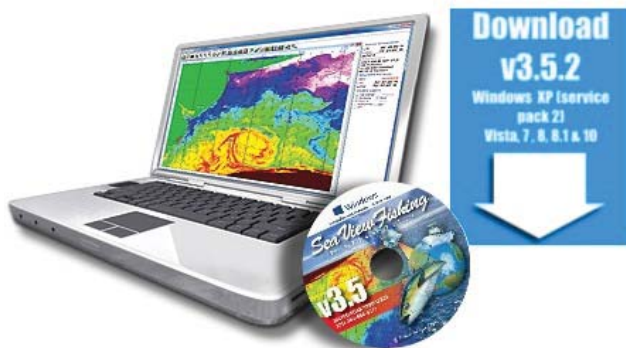
Select "**Control Panel**" from the "**Start Menu**"

Then select "**Programs > Uninstall a program**"

Find "**SeaView V3**" in the applications list and select it.

Right click and select "**Uninstall**" from the flyout menu.

Step 1A: Installing SeaView from an installer file downloaded from our web site



To download the appropriate installer file for your OS, click the link above (with a high-speed internet connections only) or go to www.SeaViewFishing.com/DownloadSoftware.html.

1. Click on the blue "DOWNLOAD v3.5.2" Windows link

2. When the File Download window comes up, click on the "**Save**" button and **save the SV3_Installer_v352.exe installer file to your PC's Desktop or a USB drive to take to the boat computer**

3. After the file download is complete, you should see an icon on your Desktop (or on the USB drive) named "SV3_Installer_v352.exe". To start the installation, double-click on this icon to start the SeaView upgrade installation.

(OR) Step 1B: Installing SeaView from a CD

Insert the installation CD into the CD-ROM or DVD drive on your computer.

If CD "auto-run" is enabled on your computer, the installation program will begin to run shortly.

A small installation screen should appear automatically.

If no installation screen appears, locate and left-click on the drive containing the installation CD.

Locate the file "**SeaView_Installer_v352.exe**" file and double click it.

The installation process should begin.

Step 2: Continue to follow along with the setup program, accepting the defaults whenever possible.

Depending on the configuration of your system, several helper programs may be installed along with SeaView. There may be short pauses between the installations of these helpers. Be patient, and continue to follow the instructions that appear on the screen. **DO NOT cancel the installation process** during these pauses.

When the installation is complete, you should see a new **"SeaView"** shortcut icon on your desktop.

Important! - A "ReadMe" window will pop up at the end of the installation. If you are running with Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8 or Windows 10, be sure to follow these instructions to set SeaView to "Run as Administrator." No need to do this if you are running Windows XP. Please see below:

If you're running Windows Vista, 7, 8, or 10, YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING AFTER INSTALLATION and BEFORE providing 16-digit code to us to obtain an unlock code:

Right-click the SeaView icon on your desktop

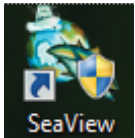
Select "properties" from the list

Select the "compatibility tab"

If you have one, verify that the checkbox under Admin Privileges is set to "Run this program as administrator." If you do not have this checkbox, then this procedure doesn't affect you.

Step 3: Open SeaView

Once the installation is finished, only the demo version of SeaView will be active until your SeaView software is **"unlocked."** SeaView will need to be **"unlocked"** in order to use the program other than in "demo mode" (i.e. to download data for your specific region).



Locate the **"SeaView"** icon on your desktop and double-click to open it.

Step 4: "Unlocking" the SeaView Software

To obtain an unlock code and data access:

You will have to have to **either call or email** Ocean Imaging with your 16-digit code in order to obtain an unlocking code and an assigned username for data-access.

A window will appear stating that SeaView is operating in "Demo Mode."
Click on the **"Register SeaView"** button.

Once you enter the unlock code, a **"SeaView Successfully Unlocked!"** message window should appear. If an unlock code is unsuccessful, the registration code provided must be rechecked for accuracy.

Step 5: Activating Your Account for Data Access

The next step is to get started with a user account and determine the length of subscription you would like. Your accessible fishing Regions will be linked-to and controlled by your uniquely assigned Username (specific to each computer installation)..

If you are a current SeaView subscriber, you will have the ability to download new data from Ocean Imagings servers.
